myFOXdetroit.com Staff - "It's a great time to be part of the big three" says UAW President Bob King in an exclusive interview with Fox 2's Murray Feldman. The two talked about the auto industry and the future role of the UAW on the floor of Detroit's Cobo Center during press preview days of the North American International Auto Show.

King was elected UAW president in June of 2010 by delegates of the UAW's Constitutional Convention in Detroit.

It seemed fitting to conduct an interview on the floor of the auto show where this year both the car and truck of the year awards went to domestic automakers.

"All laid-off UAW workers will get their jobs back" King tells Feldman. He also says that unions are the key to rebuilding America's middle class and that the path to a good economy is getting people to work good paying jobs.

He describes the union as the "UAW of the 21st-century", meaning it understands the importance of a global economy.

He says the UAW will work to organize at least one foreign owned auto plant in the United States as long as the workers' democratic right to organize is recognized. "Once we get one, others will follow" says King.

His mantra: "Common Sense and Fairness."
